

AGREEMENT CONCERNING COOPERATION BETWEEN THE DAVID AGHMASHENEBELI
NATIONAL DEFENCE ACADEMY OF GEORGIA AND THE GENERAL JONAS ŽEMAITIS
MILITARY ACADEMY OF LITHUANIA

By sharing a common mission to provide the highest quality of education at the undergraduate level and friendship, which is intended to further the academic objectives of each institution, and to promote better understanding between the faculty and students, the David Aghmashenebeli National Defence Academy of Georgia and The General Jonas Žemaitis Military Academy of Lithuania, hereinafter referred to as the “Parties”, have agreed as follows:

1. The cooperation between the Parties shall be implemented to develop civilian and military curricula, internal quality assurance procedures and mechanisms. They will implement student and academic staff exchange programs and other joint activities.
2. Any specific joint activity, program or project with legally binding obligations will be set forth in separate written agreements.
3. Treatment of intellectual property rights developed through collaborations under this agreement will be determined between the Parties through mutual consultation and separate written agreements on case-by-case basis.
4. Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this agreement.
5. This agreement does not constitute a financial commitment on the part of the Parties unless there is mutually signed agreement between the Parties.
6. Financial support (if appropriate) for each reimbursable or cooperative agreement must be fully described and is subject to ordinary budgetary and administrative procedures.
7. There is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this agreement.
8. This agreement can be amended, modified or waived only by a separate written amendment duly signed by both Parties.
9. The Parties have right to terminate this agreement at any time, with or without cause, by giving 6 (six) months written notice sent to the other Party.
10. This agreement shall enter into force on the first day of the next calendar month following the date its signature by both Parties and shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years. The period of validity can be extended upon mutual written agreement of the Parties.

This agreement is drawn up in three originals, each in the English, Lithuanian and Georgian languages, preserved by the Parties. All three originals are identical and have equal legal value. In case of different interpretation, the English version will prevail. This agreement is not international cooperation agreement.
