MOU: *BACKGROUND*



- preparation of MoU:**
 - within the framework and under the support of NATO DEEP
 - after the initial visit to Tbilisi (29MAR-1MAY 2011)
 - signed during opening ceremony of the National Defence Academy of Georgia in Gori (26OCT2012)



MOU: KEY ASPECTS

purpose:



- to advance closer partnership with NATO in the South Caucasus and the entire Black Sea region
- to advance the readiness and interoperability of national security systems within the framework of Partnership for Peace
- to promote the development of relationship and implement cooperation in the spheres of civilian and military higher education



MOU: KEY ASPECTS

scope and cooperative activities:

- collaborate in civilian and military curricula development;
- collaborate in development of internal quality assurance procedures and mechanisms;
- implement students' and academic staff exchange programs;
- develop and implement joint study programs;
- collaborate in academic and administrative staff development;
- organize joint research projects, including conferences, seminars and meetings;
- promote implementation of the main principles of Bologna Process in military education;
- share and exchange information and publications;
- collaborate in implementation of information technologies in teaching and research;
- implement other joint activities.





MOU: *FURTHER STEPS - PROPOSALS*

organizational-administrative proposals:

- annually:
 - till the end of February exchange the next-year cooperation proposals
 - till the end of March exchange mutually reviewed cooperation proposals
- purpose: to include to proposals to MoDs' plan for next year
- resources:** no-additional resources required

military/civilian curricula development:

- cooperation within the NATO DEEP framework
- resources :** NATO DEEP support



MOU: *FURTHER STEPS - PROPOSALS*

implement students' and academic staff exchange programs:

- academic staff one week stay exchange
- resources:** NATO DEEP support

organize joint research projects, including conferences, seminars and meetings

- multi-year projects, training (courses) and workshops
- potential source of funding:** NATO Science for Peace and Security (SPS)

share and exchange information and publications:

- mutual publishing activities
- UoD scientific journals:
- resources:** no additional sources required
