



"ACADEMIC INTEGRITY FOR QUALITY TEACHING AND LEARNING IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN GEORGIA"

The National Defence Academy is participant of Erasmus+ CBHE Programme 2017 call funded project – "INTEGRITY -Academic Integrity for Quality Teaching and Learning in Higher Education Institutions in Georgia". The core objective of the project is to enhance the quality of teaching and learning processes that are based on the principles of academic integrity and supported by policies, mechanisms and tools that help prevent and detect cases of plagiarism in higher education institutions in Georgia.

Within the project significant changes were implemented related to plagiarism and very successful events were organized to raise the awareness about plagiarism. We design and launch an institutional PR campaign as an important promotional mechanism that targets both students and faculty staff and conducted trainings, meetings and in house workshops regularly. We managed to develop services to improve student writing skills, delivered training to military instructors in academic writing and in effective assessment. Furthermore, "The rule of Plagiarism Detection and Response" was formed at the academy. The document defines our approach and effective actions in case of plagiarism. It should be especially highlighted that during the project the academy got free licenses of the originality checking program - Turnitin that helped us a lot to control and check each academic paper created by our Junker and faculty members.
