General guidelines for submitted papers

Requirements:

Please, submit a scientific paper and an abstract as two separate files (paper, abstract in two languages).

Abstracts:

The volume of the abstract is 100-300 words;

The abstract should be in two languages: Georgian and English;

Keywords should be provided in Georgian and English.

Submitted papers:

Scientific papers are accepted in Georgian or English languages;

The paper includes an abstract in the original language of the paper;

Article length: minimum 6 and maximum 10 pages;

Keywords should be provided in Georgian and English;

The paper should consist of the following parts:

- An introduction that explains the relevance of the paper;
- The body, which includes the research methodology and the obtained results;
- A concluding section that includes findings, possible recommendations, and future prospects.

Author (s) name, surname, university, program / specialty must be in Georgian and English; The article should include information about the supervisor (if any) and a bibliography in English (list of references);

Abstracts and articles

- follow the Chicago academic style;
- have Sylfaen for font;
- have font size for topic name, participant name, surname, name of the higher education institution, academic degree, name of the supervisor, surname 12; main text 12;
- should have the titles of the constituent parts in bold text (**BOLD**);
- Citation should follow Chicago academic style:

Book: Author's surname, separated by a comma when several authors, "Article title," Journal name, issue number (year): page.

- Spacing between rows 1.5;
- Page margins 1.5;
- Drawings, graphs, diagrams, etc. TIFF format 300 dpi; 600 dpi;
- Formulas must be typed in Microsoft equation 3.0.
