

Standard for Writing the Paper

Standard:

In order to publish the paper in the journal, the applicant must submit both a scientific paper and an abstract in a separate file (paper, abstract in English).

Rules for Writing an Abstract:

The volume of the abstract is 100-300 words.

The abstract must be given in English.

Keywords should be given in English.

Rules for Submitting the Paper:

The paper should be sent to defenseandscience@eta.edu.ge

Scientific papers are accepted only in the English language.

The paper includes an abstract in the original language of the paper.

Volume of the article must be minimum 4 and maximum 10 pages.

The structure of the article should include the following components:

- Introduction, which includes the relevance of the paper.
- Body text, which includes the research methodology and the results obtained.
- Conclusion, which includes findings, possible recommendations and future perspectives.

Author(s) name, surname, university, program / specialty should be given in English.

The article should include the information about the supervisor (if available) and the bibliography (list of references) in English.

Abstract Formatting Guidelines:

The paper should be formatted according to the Chicago Referencing Style;

- Font – Sylfaen.
- Font size: title of the topic, participant's name and surname, name of the higher education institution, academic degree, supervisor's name and surname - 12; Body text - 12.
- The titles of the components of the paper should be given in bold (BOLD);
- Citation should be in line with the Chicago Referencing Style:

Book: Name and surname of the author. Book Name, City, Publishing House, Date.

Article: Author's surname, separated by a comma in case of several authors, "Title of the Article", Name of the Journal, Publication Number (Year): Page.

- Line spacing - 1.5.
- Page margins - 2.5 on all sides.
- Sketches, graphs, diagrams, etc. - TIFF format 300 dpi; 600 dpi;
- Formulas must be typed in Microsoftequation 3.0.
