<u>Standard:</u>

In order to participate in the conference, the competitor must submit both a scientific paper and abstract in a separate file (paper, abstract in English).

Abstract execution rule:

The volume of the abstract is 100-300 words.

The abstract must be in English.

Keywords should be given in English;

Rules for submitting paper:

The paper should be sent to <u>conference@eta.edu.ge</u>

Scientific papers are accepted only in English language;

The paper includes an abstract in the original language of the paper;

Article volume must be minimum 4 and maximum 10 pages;

The structure of the article should include the following parts:

Introduction, which includes the relevance of the paper;

- Introduction, which includes the relevance of the paper;
- The main part, which includes the research methodology and the obtained results;
- Final part, which includes findings, possible recommendations and future perspectives. Author (s) name, surname, university, program / specialty must be in English; The article should be accompanied by information about supervisor (if available) and a bibliography in English (list of references);

Abstract Formatting Guidelines:

The paper should be designed according to the Chicago academic style;

- Font Sylfaen;
- Font size: topic name, participant name, surname, name of the higher education institution, academic degree, supervisor name, surname 12; Main text 12.
- The titles of the constituent parts of the paper should be in bold (BOLD);
- Citation should be in line with Chicago academic style:

Book: Surname of the author, first name. Book Name, City, Publishing House, Date.

Article: Author's surname, separated by commas in case of several authors, "title of the Article" Journal name, Publication Number (Year): Page.

- Space between rows 1.5;
- Page margins 2.5 on all sides;
- Page margins 2.5 on all sides;
- Drawings, graphs, diagrams, etc. TIFF format 300 dpi; 600 dpi;
- Formulas must be typed in Microsoftequation 3.0.
